RESOLUTION NO. 1581

REMOVING CEBU CITY AS TESTING CENTER FOR THE DECEMBER 2022 AERONAUTICAL ENGINEERS LICENSURE EXAMINATION

WHEREAS, Section 7 (d) of Republic Act No. 8981 or the "PRC Modernization Act of 2000" empowers the Professional Regulation Commission (Commission) to administer and conduct the licensure examinations of the various regulatory boards in accordance with the rules and regulations it may promulgate and to determine and fix the places and dates of examinations;

WHEREAS, the Commission issued Resolution No. 1439 (s. 2021) scheduling the Aeronautical Engineers Licensure Examination (AELE) on November 15, 16 and 17, 2022 in the National Capital Region (NCR) and Cebu City;

WHEREAS, the Commission issued Resolution No. 1569 (s. 2022) rescheduling the AELE from November 15, 16 and 17, 2022 to December 14, 15 and 16, 2022;

WHEREAS, the Professional Regulatory Board of Aeronautical Engineering (Board), per its Memorandum dated 28 September 2022, is requesting to conduct the AELE in the NCR only as it was observed that there are few examinees of the said examination outside NCR;¹

WHEREAS, the Board and the Licensure Office, thus, recommended to the Commission to remove Cebu City as a testing center for the December 2022 AELE.

WHEREFORE, in view of the foregoing, the Commission **RESOLVES**, as it hereby **RESOLVED**, to **REMOVE** Cebu City as a testing center for the December 2022 Aeronautical Engineers Licensure Examination.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the affected examinees, if any, shall be transferred by the PRC Cebu Regional Office to the PRC-NCR.

All Commission offices/divisions are enjoined to undertake the necessary coordination to ensure the smooth and orderly conduct of the licensure examination.
