2. Report to the school/building assignment before 6:30 A.M. on the first day of examination to verify your room and seat number. Be punctual. Late examinees will not be admitted.
3. **BRING YOUR HAND LENS, STREAK PLATE, HAND MAGNET, ETCH FOR ROCKS AND MINERALS IDENTIFICATION ON TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 23, 2016.**
4. Examinees are required to wear the following attire every examination day:
 - Male Examinees - Plain white polo shirts with collar (without any seal, logo or mark)
decent pants/slacks
 - Female Examinees- Plain white blouse or shirt with collar (without any seal, logo or mark)
decent pants/skirt


5. Bring the following on examination day:

 - e) Ball pens with **BLACK INK** only

 - g) One (1) piece long transparent/plastic envelope (for keeping your valuables and other allowed items)

 - b) PROGRAMMABLE CALCULATORS
 - c) **CELLULAR PHONES, LAPTOP** or similar gadgets/devices

 - e) Other examination aides not stated on this program shall not be brought inside the building
