GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Your school/building assignment will be posted outside the PRC premises and at the PRC website (www.prc.gov.ph) one or two days before the examination. Bring your **NOTICE OF ADMISSION** when you verify your school/building assignment.
2. Report to the school/building assignment before 6:30 AM on the first day of the examination to verify your room and seat number. Be punctual. Late examinees will not be admitted.
3. Examinees are required to wear the following attire every examination day:
 1. Male Examinees - Plain white polo shirts with collar (without any seal, logo or mark)
decent pants or slacks
 2. Female Examinees - Plain white blouse or shirt with collar (without any seal logo or mark)
decent pants or slacks
4. Bring the following on examination day:
 - a. Notice of Admission
 - b. Official Receipt
 - c. One (1) piece metered-stamped window mailing envelope
 - d. Two (2) or more pencils (No. 2)
 - e. Ballpens with **BLACK** ink only
 - f. One (1) piece long brown envelope
 - g. One (1) piece long transparent/plastic envelope (for keeping your valuables and other allowed items)
 - h. Non-programmable Calculator (refer to list on the Examinees Guide).

5. The following are **PROHIBITED** inside the examination premises/rooms:
- Books, notes, review materials, and other printed materials containing coded data/information/formula
 - PROGRAMMABLE CALCULATORS**
 - CELLULAR PHONES**, beepers, portable computers or similar gadgets/devices.
 - Bags of any kind (ladies bag, shoulder bags, attache' case, backpacks, etc.)
 - Other examination aides not stated on this program.

 - **Furniture Design and Construction**
3 sheets Paper A3 (16.5" x 11.75")
 - **Materials of Design and Decoration**
1 sheet (8.5" x 14")
 - **History of Arts and Interior Design**
1 sheet Tracing paper A4
(210mmx297mm) for each above subject.
 - **Interior Construction and Utilities**
5 sheets Bond paper with drawings A4
(210mx297mm)
 - **Color Theory**
5 sheets Water Color Paper A4 will be provided by the PRC for rendering.
 - **Professional Practice and Ethics**
No specific requirement.
- Candidates will not be allowed to leave the examination room, borrow anything or communicate with one another on any subject matter. Every candidate is requested to bring his/her lunch during the examination. No food of any kind will be received for any candidate during the progress of the examination.
